Paul graduated from The University of Leeds with a Bachelors degree in Civil and Structural Engineering in June 2003, before going on to complete a Master of Arts degree in International and European Business Law at the same University whilst working part time at Civic Engineers (previously Stockley), Paul then took up a full time role on completion of his degree.

Paul's experience at the practice includes the design and delivery of high specification structural engineering projects, refurbishment of historic and listed building structures, development appraisal and infrastructure strategies, site remediation and enabling, highways, public realm and drainage design (including SuDS), contract administration and construction management. Paul has also worked with Places Matter! to deliver a series of workshops on the implementation of Manual for Streets.

- •Road Bridge Connection to Development Site, Worsley (2013) Scheme design of

- a road bridge to enable development on a land locked site in Worsley. The bridge weaves around existing trees to minimise the impact on the local environment.
- Park Lane, Poynton (2011-2012) Detailed design of this exemplar shared space scheme in the heart of Poynton for Cheshire East Council.
- New Bolton Woods, Bradford (2011-2014) Masterplan and infrastructure strategy for over 1000 new homes and other uses on a steep hillside site to the north of Bradford to be submitted for planning in July 2014. The client is a partnership between Urbo and BMDC, we are working with masterplanners Urbed and Architect OMI.
- Oldham Gateway Housing PFI (2010-2014) Design of s38 highway works including shared surface streets, and public realm for this Housing PFI which includes 430 new homes.
